Cool Thoughts

It has been nearly three months since the Class of 2018 walked up the steps of the beautiful academic quad and graduated from this great University. More importantly, those same graduates also walked down such steps to be embraced by family and friends who brought them to the threshold of their lives as part of the University of Rochester family! And they have walked into a world armed with the gift of faith and reason to make a real difference.

This July, I began my 19th year of college chaplaincy at Rochester. With each passing day, I become ever aware of the importance of time and, indeed, how precious it is, along with the honor I have in ministering to some incredible young people. I see it nearly every day as students hustle from one class to another, one meal to the next, one recitation or workshop to another, not including the countless executive board/club meetings and all-night study sessions that pervade their lives. I also see how faith equally impacts their lives as they seek to grow close to God by attending Mass or a retreat, coming to confession, performing service for the less fortunate, or simply making sense of their young lives while facing great difficulties.

As the fiscal year comes to a close, I reflect on the sequential and see that time does have a deeper meaning than that of the inexhaustible task list of outward measured success. It becomes the vehicle by which we direct our lives to participate in and learn new and exciting things; the process by which we experience each other’s joys, anxieties, fears, and doubts; the way in which we seek out those things which matter most, and which offer something beyond the temporal. Decisively, our time on earth allows us to see and do things in preparation for the eternal.

In my nearly two decades at the University, I have seen this version of time become a need for students—one to seek out and embrace this deeper reality here at Newman. Take Sergio, for example, who comes from Brazil. Although baptized a Christian, he never received any sort of religious education or instruction except what Newman offered, and thus he decided to walk with others in our faith formation program and was Confirmed this past Easter.

Take Philip, who came to us with three days left in his senior year so terribly fearful he could barely talk, let alone think. He just discovered he was three credits short of graduating. With his parents literally on their way to campus, graduation was now put on hold. While not able to overcome every obstacle, we were able to walk with him beyond the fear that had him in tears. Newman helped him design a new path forward.

Or Kim, who learned she was a match for her aunt who needed a liver transplant. Despite having dozens of friends, she wanted to tell no one else on campus. Sr. Leandra accompanied Kim to a decision that only she could make for herself. Her faith was a light in the darkness of uncertainty.

Time allows for the many undulations within our lives to occur—always paving the way for the positivity of the future. And in our particular circumstance of working with students and their struggles on a daily basis, this creative optimism—always grounded in faith—allows those same students to succeed.

With that being said, Sergio will now become a leader in our 2018–19 RCIA program, guiding those in the very same position he once found himself! Philip has just completed his summer class in order to gain his three credits needed to receive his Rochester diploma. And Kim welcomes your prayers for recovery of her successful surgery and for her aunt on the way to a new life gifted by the incredible generosity of her niece.

These examples are just three of the many challenges our students faced this past year due to the uncertainties of time. Your own dedication, prayer, and generosity during this period exemplify your commitment to Newman’s mission and vision. And it is your ongoing support that provides grace to Newman students at Rochester in so many ways and reflects your devotion to making a difference each and every day to those we hold dear, including those mentioned above and so many more.
