





Within this Annual Report, truly it gives me great joy to share with you the incredible resiliency and growth that the students we serve have experienced over this past year and beyond. Given the pandemic and all the restrictions on campus, it was hard—very hard! Nevertheless, through the last 18 months of frightening days, our students came to Christ on Sundays and in so many other ways that would make you proud. Additionally, it gives me great pleasure to thank you and many like you who know the importance of Catholic life at the University of Rochester and support the Newman Community's daily ministry. Above all, I have great hope as I share with you that we have only just begun! Because of your efforts, Newman is positioned for even greater things in the years ahead. And for the first time in our over 60-year history, we are in a position for expansion because of your generosity and the over 70 student leaders we have working to bring students to Christ and the Church. These efforts and your kindness will not only continue to make Newman ministry grow, but soon bring about the long dreamed and talked about Catholic Newman Center and Chapel.

It all begins with our students. And this too is growing! Newman is the largest religious denomination on campus and one of the most robust ministry programs in the country. On August 18, the amazing Class of 2025 arrived on campus. They are the largest first-year class in University of Rochester history with some 1,450 strong (not to mention another 130 students from Eastman's Class of 2025)! Fittingly, they are also one of the largest Catholic classes of students when they come through the Interfaith Chapel doors in a few weeks' time. The Newman Class of 2025 already numbers over 200 first-years registered, with more set to register once classes start. This takes the total number of registered Catholic students we engage to over 800, and of course we serve so many more.

A Place to Pray, A Place to Gather, and A Place to Grow is indeed what Newman embodies in so many ways. It is a fitting slogan for our building campaign and for all that Newman does. With you and your sacrifices, Newman will meet not only the challenges set before us, but as this last year has shown, we will ascend to the greatest of heights. As I have said often, I pinch myself at the opportunity before us! I also know that the Holy Spirit is guiding this project to build a Catholic Chapel/Center on a private secular University. Only could the Holy Spirit give us the opportunity; provide an amazing parcel of land; find a lead donor and other donors who followed him; and bring us to the 75% threshold of our fundraising goal. And it is the Holy Spirit who has now positioned us to invite all Newman alumni, parents, and friends to get behind this historic project.

In the next couple of months, the Newman Community and the University will

 Receive formal approval from the University of Rochester Board of Trustees Committee on Facilities and Campus Planning

- Complete the 50-year Memorandum of Understanding, which has no obstacles for dynamic Catholic life
- Hire an architect to create schematic designs and detailed costs
- Hire a liturgical consultant for designing the Catholic Chapel for Mass and perpetual prayer for students
- Identify donors for remaining naming opportunities and permanent gifts
- Embark on a broad-based public phase of the building campaign to bring us beyond our goals!



May God bless you and we thank you once more!



Year-End Fiscal Results July 1, 2020–June 30, 2021


2020-2021 Operating Income: \$370,755
